

### PURPOSE OF THE FOUNDATION

The Rollin M. Gerstacker Foundation was founded by Mrs. Eda U. Gerstacker in 1957, in memory of her husband. Its primary purpose is to carry on, indefinitely, financial aid to charities of all types supported by Mr. and Mrs. R. M. Gerstacker during their lifetimes. These charities are concentrated in the states of Michigan and Ohio.

### Foundation Annual Letter

As we reflect upon our work in 2019 and prepare for the challenges of 2020, the Rollin M. Gerstacker Foundation is experiencing a period of significant change. Alan Ott, our dear friend and treasurer of the Foundation for 24 years, passed away in early January.

Alan Ott became a trustee in 1985 and worked side-by-side with Carl Gerstacker for many years. He was called "Mr. Midland" for his dedication to his hometown. He was an outstanding banker and problem solver. Alan also provided the leadership and financial expertise to propel the Foundation into the 21st century and to prepare us for the future.

Alan's wife Jean; son Jeff and his wife Mary Ann, grandson Alex; and, daughter Amy were blessed with a husband, father, and grandfather who lived a meaningful life. We at the Foundation and his friends throughout Michigan will miss him immensely.

2019 was a year of significant accomplishment for the Rollin M. Gerstacker Foundation. With the help of our outstanding Board of Trustees and talented administrative team, we had an impactful year supporting many important projects in Midland and surrounding communities. With a grant of \$1,425,000, we welcome Delta College to downtown Midland. The construction of the Delta College Midland Center brings a new and expanding educational footprint to Midland's lively downtown.

We are also pleased to participate in Midland's new Central Park Miracle Field. Along with other funders, we invested \$500,000 to build a universally accessible baseball complex to assist individuals with special needs. The words, "Play Ball" now take on a deeper meaning.

We have a long history of supporting victims of domestic violence and sexual assault. Our \$600,000 grant toward the construction of the new Shelterhouse facility in Midland will help provide a safe and secure environment for women, men and children in our community.

A \$10,000 grant was awarded to the Cleveland (Mrs. Eda Gerstacker's hometown) Zoological Society to provide animal care and welfare, science education and the conservation and protection of wildlife.

We awarded 131 grants in 2019, in the total amount of \$8,468,557, for education, music and the arts, health care, social services, youth activities and a variety of additional community projects.

2020 will present significant challenges to many families throughout the Great Lake State. We are confident that by working together we can provide hope and help to our local communities.

The Rollin M. Gerstacker Foundation remains committed to the mission of our founders and we are mindful of the past guidance of both Carl Gerstacker and Alan Ott. We will continue to be a catalyst for economic growth both in Midland and the surrounding region, with the goal of building stronger communities and a stronger Michigan.
